

Caryophyllaceae (Pink Family)

Phenology: unknown

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coronado NF, Gila NF)

Similar Species: recently described as a new species; formerly part of *S. longipes* and differs from other taxa in the *S. longipes* complex by solitary flowers in the leaf axils and its erect habit (not forming mats).

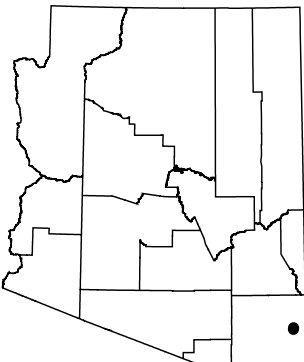
