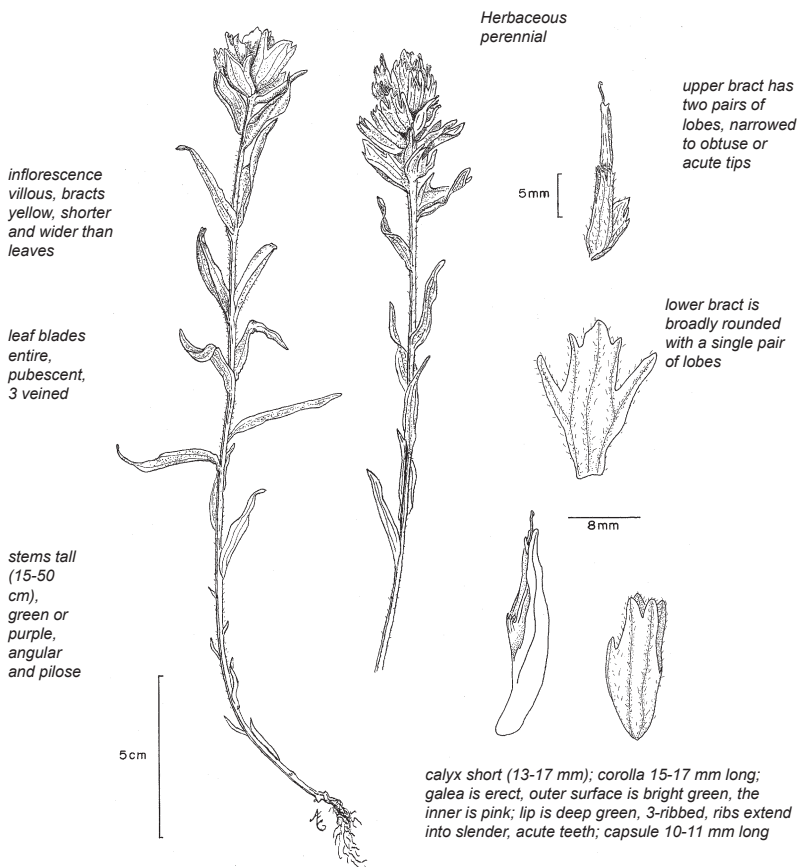


WHITE MOUNTAINS PAINTBRUSH

*Scrophulariaceae (Snapdragon Family)*

Phenology: flowers late June through August, sets seed mid-July through September.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Apache-Sitgreaves NF), White Mountain Apache Tribe.

Similar Species: *C. lineata* has flowers that can be confused with *C. mogollonica*, but *C. lineata* leaves always have 3-5 distinct linear lobes. *C. miniata* may have yellow inflorescences, but they are longer (> 2 cm) than *C. mogollonica*.

Notes: populations have suffered from habitat degradation and trampling from livestock.

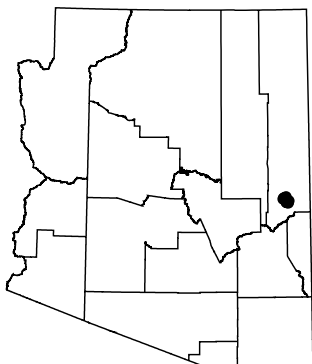
Castilleja mogollonica

Habitat: moderately drained wet grassy meadows and high elevation cienegas. Plants not found in the wettest part of the meadow. Associated plant community is subalpine meadow within mixed conifer forests at elevations of 8,500-9,500 ft (2600-2900 m).
