

Cactaceae (Cactus Family)

Phenology: flowers produced on stem apex in June and July.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coronado NF).

Synonym: *Mammillaria recurvata* Engelm.

Notes: surveys conducted by Coronado NF in recent years have expanded the numbers, but not significantly increased the known range of the cactus.

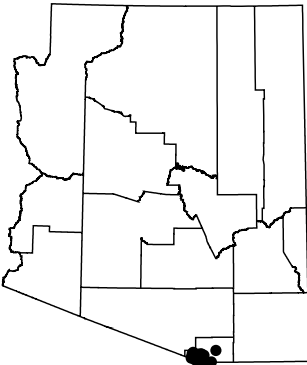

Habitat: rocky hillsides and/or rock crevices. Found in the valleys and foothills of oak woodlands and desert grasslands, 3,500-5,500 ft (1065-1680 m) elevation.
