

Phenology: flowers from late May through June. **Management Responsibility:** Navajo Nation.

Similar Species: the stems, leaves, and phyllaries of *E. consimilis* are gray green; its stems are scapose, and its phyllaries are thickened along the margins.



Habitat: steep, barren, shale slopes of the Chinle Formation, at 6,100-7,381 ft (1860-2250 m) elevation, in desertscrub and pinyonjuniper woodland communities.





Range: only known from northern Apache County, Arizona, and McKinley County, New Mexico.
