*Polygonaceae (Knotweed/Buckwheat Family)*

**Phenology:** flowering and fruiting July-October.

**Management Responsibility:** BLM (AZ Strip Field Office), Kaibab Band of Paiute Indians, AZ Dept of Transportation.

**Similar Species:** *Eriogonum mortonianum* has elliptic leaves which are glabrous on both sides. *E. corymbosum* has elliptic leaves which are hairy on both surfaces. Hybrid intermediates are at least as common as the parent taxa. They are difficult to distinguish when leafless in winter.

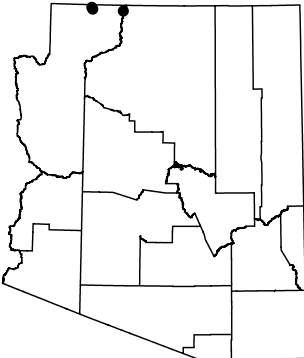
