

Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

Phenology: grows and flowers with late summer monsoon rains.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Coronado NF).

Notes: of the four known sites in Arizona, only one site (in the Huachuca


Mountains) has been confirmed since 1990.

Habitat: found at high elevations above 8,000 ft (2440 m) within the mixed conifer forests.

Range: in the Catalina, Chiricahua, Huachuca, and Pinaleno mountain ranges; also found in New Mexico within the Mogollon range, and from Guadalupe y Calvo in Chihuahua, Mexico.
