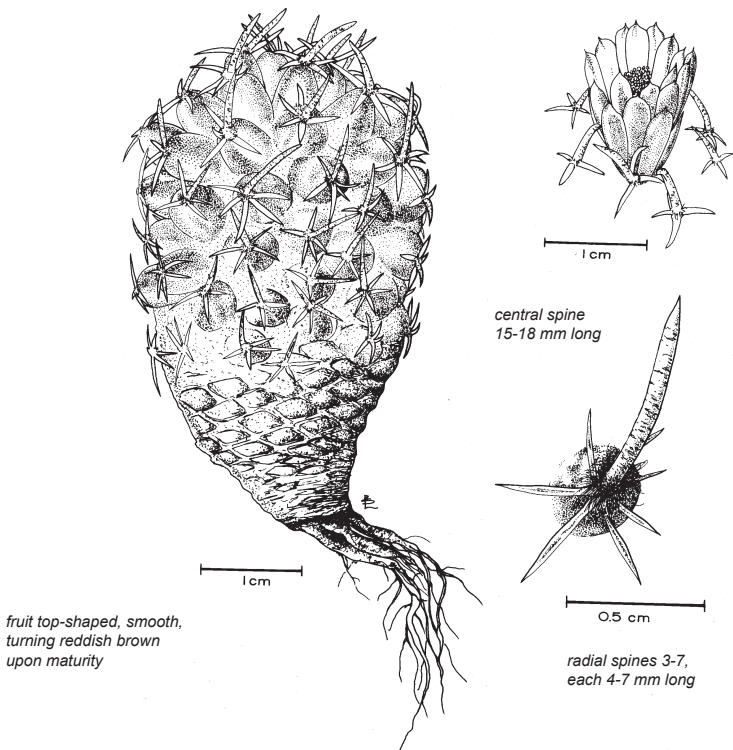
Pediocactus peeblesianus

FICKEISEN PINCUSHION CACTUS

var. *fickeiseniae*

Stems 2.5-6.0 cm tall,
2.0-5.5 cm in diameter,
spherical, usually
solitary

flowers cream-yellow or
yellowish-green, to 2.5 cm
diameter, produced on the
apex of the stem



Cactaceae (Cactus Family)

Phenology: flowering in April, plants will retract into the soil in response to drought.

Land Ownership/ Management: USFS (Kaibab NF), BLM (AZ Strip Field Office), NPS (Glen Canyon NRA), Navajo Nation, AZ Dept of Transportation.

Synonyms: *Navajoa fickeisenii* Backeberg, *Toumeyia fickeisenii* (Backeberg) Kladiwa.

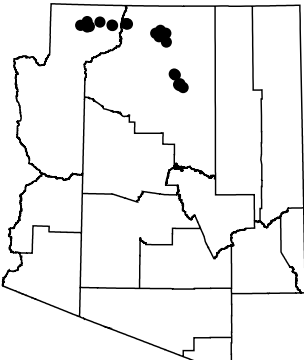
