

SHEEP RANGE BEARDTONGUE


Shrubby perennial
9-20 cm tall

calyx 4-7 mm long;
corolla 13-17 mm long,
staminate slightly
exserted, with short
yellow hairs

showy pink/red flowers

thick holly-like basal
leaves, 7-40 mm long

branching stems



Scrophulariaceae (Snapdragon Family)

Phenology: flowering May; fruiting May and June.

Management Responsibility: BLM (AZ Strip Field Office).

Notes: a rare plant with few threats due to its inaccessible habitat.


Penstemon petiolatus
