

Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

Phenology: main flowering May to June, but may bloom into August; presumably seeds mature and are dispersed in June, July or early fall.

Management Responsibility: USFS (Apache-Sitgreaves NF).

Synonym: *Packera quaerens* (Greene) W.A. Weher and Á. Löve

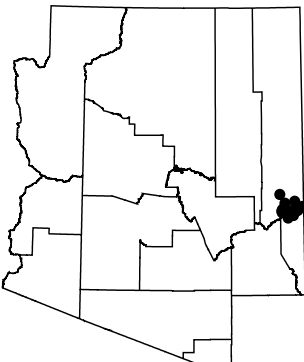

Habitat: high elevation riparian spruce fir and ponderosa pine forests; usually among shrubby or grassy hummocks in partial shade of forest over-story (half to full shade); also known from logged areas, 7,500-9,200 ft (2285-2800 m) elevation.
