

Cucurbitaceae (Melon/Gourd Family)

Phenology: dormant during winter, early spring, flowers July-August, fruits August-September.

Management Responsibility: BLM (Phoenix Field Office, Tucson Field Office), NPS (Saguaro NP, Organ Pipe NM), Tohono O'odham Nation, AZ State Land, Dept, USFS (Coronado NF), private.

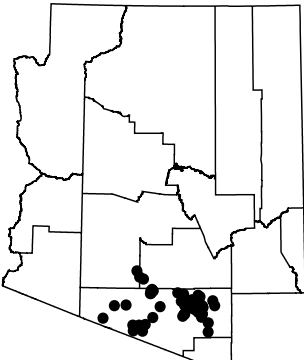
